iii. Grants for Teachers: A. O'Neil reported on 2024, redesigned Grant for Teachers, the 2 different award options and parameters. CAC held a June 12, 2024 ceremony and there were 12 Arts Council recipients. Accepted 4 out of 7 applicants from Golden. Mark Golden at Ceremony; all teachers spoke about their projects. January 2025 reports are due. All teachers have been invited to bring completed projects as a gallery exhibit of final results in March or April 2025.

- SECSD Had a multi discipline collaborative project to interview Veterans and will create an art project with it.
- V. Executive Director's Report:

- **NYSCA Grant Possibility**: A. O'Neil discussed a new NYSCA grant, starts at \$20,000 and cap is whatever half of the organization's budget is. It is not currently in the budget. Would benefit all areas of the organization if received.

- **DRI Update**: A. O'Neil reported that CAC was one of 10 organizations awarded by DRI grant to renovate theater; sound has been upgrades. Lights are next and will be replaced with LED light. Traditionally lighting in theater is a lamp with colored gel put in it. The new lights and casings will be LED and digital, totally computer operated. Got quote from Principle Designs to renovate the theater.

- Hold-up has been the Environmental Survey report for the state; main issue could be asbestos and lead paint. update on DRI; waiting to hear back from Fire Chief and Zoning Officer. Project is inside. Waiting to find out if we need a special permit; looking into if we need a sign stating is a NYSDRI project; got a quote for asbestos & lead paint. Eric Scrivener is assisting.
